## A BRIEF REPORT ON TANGENT INDIA

2010-2011 has without doubt been a good year for Tangent India.

The year, which began with our 2<sup>nd</sup> AGM at Kerala last September, will come to a close this September (17.9.11) in Delhi. Our 3<sup>rd</sup> NAGM will be held on that day and we are expecting a large number of members representing many clubs to attend.

I have been extremely lucky in my Board members. Tangent India has 5 such, and together we have achieved some small measure of success. The most notable progress has been on the Extension front.

The number of clubs in India now stands at 10. 4 new clubs were chartered this year, in Kolkata, Bangalore and in Bhubaneswar. We have now approx 140 members, which even include a couple of active Circlers! Tangent India welcomes 41Club wives, Round Table wives and of course, past Circlers. And, four more groups of such ladies in different parts of this large country are showing keen interest in forming Tangent Clubs.

Communication, without which an organization cannot survive, has been most satisfying with a marked improvement in the use of emails. It has helped to bring us closer and foster a spirit of belonging. As a major tool of this communication thrust, it was decided to bring out a new Directory, our second, in July. Otherwise, it was felt, the members of the 4 new clubs would not have any identity.

Contact was maintained through the year with Ladies Circle India and material on Tangent sent to them to be circulated to past Circlers. Letters, greetings etc were regularly exchanged with Tangent GB who have been extremely supportive and given us a much-needed exposure to the international scene.

Tangent India has received enormous publicity this year nationally and internationally. We have been featured in all 4 issues of the 41Clubs of India magazine and an article by me on TI was printed in The Hinge, the 41 International magazine giving us recognition in the international community as well. All this I hope will result in increase in membership, in awareness that Tangent India is in its formative stage and can be modulated to become relevant to our lives....Tangent is our club, it is up to us to make it a happy place to be in!
